Road Construction Update The reconstruction of CTH R from Waldo Boulevard to CTH P is scheduled to start during the week of March 11th, 2024. The project scope consists of grading, base aggregate, concrete pavement, storm sewer, culvert pipe, asphaltic surface, curb and gutter, signing, landscaping and pavement marking. Traffic thru the project will only be allow going Southbound in a single lane configuration while Northbound traffic will be detoured at the Waldo Boulevard intersection west to I-43 north to STH 310 east to CTH R. Two-way traffic will be maintained from Waldo Boulevard to Wildwood for access to Manitowoc Lutheran High School until the school year is finished.

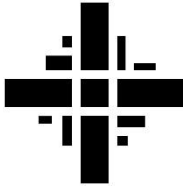
