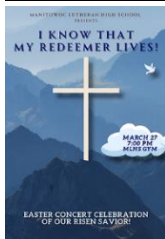
Registration is open! So, I encourage you to go talk to your fellow church members, family, and friends. Attend in a group or come individually, and bond with fellow women who share the same callings!

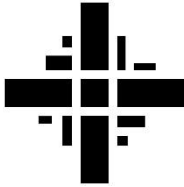
